

**ERECTOR SET Workshop
Supplies and Pre-Cutting
Jane Hardy Miller**

Book: *French Braid Transformation*, Miller, C&T Publishing, 2011. We will be making the quilt on page 51 (or see another example on page 55). In addition to the book, you will need:

Equipment:

Sewing machine, accessories and basic sewing supplies
Good quality thread for piecing
Rotary cutter, mat and ruler—whatever you usually use
A square ruler at least 9" x 9" is very helpful, but not required

Fabric selection tips: Decide on the 2 background colors first; pick 7 fat quarters of each. Then select scraps and/or fat eighths for the dots.

Fabric requirements:

Zigzag: 7 fat quarters in EACH of 2 colors, or 7 light and 7 dark of 1 color (14 total)

Dots: several fat eighths or scraps (5/8 yard if using 1 fabric)

Fusible web (if used for appliqué): 5/8 yard (18" wide or wider)

Inner border: 3/8 yard

Outer border: 2 yards cut lengthwise or 1 1/4 yards cut crosswise

Backing: 4 5/8 yards pieced lengthwise OR 3 3/4 yards pieced crosswise

Binding: 5/8 yard

Please follow the instructions on page 52 to cut your fat quarters.
