

STACKED BLOX
One-Day Workshop
Supplies and Pre-Cutting

Pattern: *Stacked Blox* by Jane Hardy Miller for Urban Elementz
(www.urbanelementz.com)

Equipment:

Sewing machine, accessories and basic sewing supplies
Good quality thread for piecing
Rotary cutter and mat
Rotary ruler to cut up to 4½" strips

Fabric selection tips: Do not make the background for the stacked squares too light in relation to the others, as it tends to jump out. Frames should contrast with both the main fabric and the background fabric. Prints that run parallel to the selvage will be lying on their sides in the stacked squares and their background. Use a nondirectional print for the border.

Fabric requirements (for twin size; for crib size, see pattern back):

Main blocks: 1 1/4 yards
Stacked squares: 1/4 yard, fat or straight) EACH of 4 fabrics
Background for stacked squares: 7/8 yard
Frames: 1 1/4 yard
Outer border: 1 3/8 yards, cut crosswise OR 2 1/8 yards, cut lengthwise

Follow the instructions on page 1 to cut strips for the main fabric, the stacked squares, the background and the frames. Be sure you are cutting for your chosen size.
